

Report Abuse

Any School District employee, regardless of whether he/she is a “mandated reporter,” shall report suspected child abuse or neglect to the building principal or designee. The report is to protect children whose health and welfare may be jeopardized by abuse or neglect and to ensure that school district employees meet their legal reporting obligations. It is not the employee’s responsibility to determine whether or not neglect or abuse has occurred. Rather, it is the responsibility of school district employees to be faithful and timely reporters of suspected abuse or neglect so that allegations can be brought to the attention of objective, trained and experienced investigators.
